

## The History of Perth Amboy

Perth Amboy's long, rich history dates back to Dec. 8, 1651 when the Leni Lenape Indians (part of the Algonquins) granted a deed to Augustine Herman transferring the point at the mouth of the Raritan River to him. At that time, the land was known as Ompoge, which subsequently changed to Emboyle, and then to Amboyle. When the first three houses were built in 1683, settlers and officials began to call the land Ambo or Amboy, and finally Amboy. Amboy, the only city in the United States incorporated twice, received its first charter in 1718, by which time it was commonly known as Perth Amboy. It was incorporated a second time in 1784 after the American Revolution.

Where does the Perth come from? By 1684, when the Earl of Perth became Lord High Chancellor under King James II, Gawen Lawrie arrived here as deputy governor with instructions from the proprietors to refer to Amboy as the town of Perth. The Earl of Perth was also one of the members of the Board of Proprietors. Even though he was arrested upon the abdication of King James II in 1688, the town was still referred to as Perth Amboy even though the Earl was confined until 1693.

Perth Amboy is home to the only official Royal Governor's Mansion still intact since Colonial days, commonly known as the Proprietary House. The Proprietors of East Jersey were responsible for its construction during 1762-1764 for the Royal Governor of New Jersey. In 1774, William Franklin, son of Benjamin Franklin, was Royal Governor at which time he took up residence at the mansion with his wife. However, since he was arrested by the continental army in 1776, the house did not remain a Governor's mansion for long. After the Revolution, the Proprietary House became a private home. In 1809 it became a resort hotel, but business was ruined by the War of 1812. In 1883 it became a rooming house for retired Presbyterian ministers, called the Westminster. Currently, the Proprietary House is owned by the State and maintained by the Proprietary House Association.



Perth Amboy is also home to the oldest City Hall in continuous use in the United States, built during 1714-1717 or 1718, to serve as the County courthouse and jail. It burned in a fire in 1731 and was not rebuilt until 1745. It was again burned in 1765 or 1766 when a man named Martin, angered by his earlier imprisonment in the City Hall on debt charges, allegedly set fire to the building. It was rebuilt in 1767. City Hall contained court chambers, rooms for the Provincial Assembly until 1775, and was used as a schoolhouse and for community meetings. It was in City Hall that the State of New Jersey became the first state to ratify the Bill of Rights.

Although City Hall was renovated in 1826, 1872 and 2006, some of the 1717 structure still remains. The current structure is Victorian with a mansard roof and several new wings. A City Hall Park was also developed with a historic statue of George Washington and an exact replica of the Liberty Bell. In addition to the municipal offices, City Hall has been used for law courts, a jail, legislative meetings, church services, concerts, shows, public meetings, and a school.

From about 1800 to 1870, City Hall Courthouse housed the public school classes. In 1870 Perth Amboy's first public school opened on State Street. The original building, then called School One, is still in use with some additions and a new name, Thomas Mundy Peterson School. The school was named after Thomas Mundy Peterson of Perth Amboy who became the first black voter under the 15th Amendment in the United States on March 31, 1870.

During the early 1800's, Perth Amboy's waterfront was a bustling business center. It contained warehouses, eateries, rooming houses, stores with imported and local products, an outdoor produce market and docks. For many years, ferry service played an integral role in Perth Amboy for those looking to go to and from Staten Island. Begun in 1709, service finally stopped in 1963. Currently, ferry service is about to be restored for the first time in nearly 40 years.

By the late 1890's Perth Amboy also had a trolley line, the Raritan Traction Co., which ran within Perth Amboy. Around 1900 the trolley line was extended to Fords Corner, then Metuchen, Sewaren, and Woodbridge.

Perth Amboy has also made many interesting contributions to culture and commerce. In 1853, Marcus and Rebecca Spring founded the Eagleswood School, in the vicinity of the Route 35/Smith Street intersection. The school was a utopian community for intellectuals, artists, and abolitionists. Eagleswood soon became famous and was visited by the likes of Louisa May Alcott, Henry Thoreau, Ralph Waldo Emerson, Horace Greenly, and many more. Just before the Civil War, Rebecca Spring arranged to have the bodies of two men, who were hung with the abolitionist John Brown, buried on the Eagleswood grounds.

Since its beginning Perth Amboy has been a place of interesting facts. For example, did you know...

In 1752, the first professional play staged in New Jersey was performed by an English touring company in Perth Amboy.

In 1760, Samuel Neville of Perth Amboy edited the first magazine published in America, The American Magazine, under the pen name "Sylvanus Americanus".

From 1848-1849, Lawrence Kearny of Perth Amboy was still on active duty as Commodore in the Navy while mayor of his hometown ... this is the only time such a thing has happened.

In 1865, The Raritan Yacht Club was established. Still in use, it is the second oldest yacht club in America.

In 1896 the first submarine, which was designed by John Holland of Paterson, was perfected at the Industrial Iron Works and Machine Shop in Perth Amboy.

On July 4, 1912 the first air mail delivery was made to Perth Amboy from South Amboy. The five minute flight was made by hydroplane.

Perth Amboy was selected as the site for the Naval Military Academy in the State of New Jersey.

Perth Amboy used to be famous for its fresh water springs... one of which still exists.

All the Vaseline in the world once originated in Perth Amboy when the company Cheeseborough Ponds was located here.

Perth Amboy was also home to a number of distinguished artists...

John Watson (1685-1768) came to Perth Amboy in 1715. He is known as the first portrait painter in America. He started the first art gallery in the country.

William Dunlap (1766-1839) was born in Perth Amboy. He not only was an artist, and painted a portrait of George Washington, he was also a writer and play producer. His paintings can be found in numerous museums including but not limited to... the Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York; Detroit Museum of Art, Michigan; the Worcester Museum, Massachusetts; Yale University Museum, Connecticut; and the Newark Museum New Jersey.


George Inness (1825-1894) was primarily a landscape painter. He lived in Perth Amboy for some time after becoming acquainted with Rebecca and Marcus Spring, of the Eagleswood Mansion. Some of his artwork is located in the Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York City.

Edward Kemeys lived for several years at Eagleswood in Perth Amboy. He was regarded as the greatest animal sculptor in America. He modeled sculptors for the Chicago Art Institute, Metropolitan Museum of Art, Central Park, New York, and Fairmount Park, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

Harry Tierney (1891-1965) was a native to Perth Amboy. He was the composer of many Broadway musicals and a popular songwriter.

Ruth White (1919-1969) was born and died in Perth Amboy. She was a talented character actress. She appeared in Broadway shows including The Happiest Millionaire, Happy Days, and Birthday Party. In 1964 she won an Emmy Award as best supporting actress in Little Moon of Alban. She was also in movies such as To Kill a Mockingbird, and Naked City. Her brother Charles White was also a distinguished actor, both in film and on stage.

The one constant in Perth Amboy has been change, and we are still enjoying the process of evolution.



In 1983, the Lodge of No. 46 of the Danish Brotherhood in America hired the National Metal & Marble Maintenance Company, Inc. to restore the statue on the occasion of the City's 300th anniversary. Subsequent repairs were also made in 1985.




Living in Perth Amboy NJ, he worked for a terra cotta factory, sculpted statues, ornate tiles, and headmarkers. Here is one of his works and info from a book:



In 1895 the Danish and Scandinavian population of Perth Amboy commissioned Nels Nielsen Alling (1861-1955), a Danish sculptor, to create the statue of George Washington. It was to express pride and love for their adopted country. The funds were raised within the Scandinavian community and the statue was dedicated on 2 September 1895. Alling worked on the statue at the the NJ Terra Cotta Co in Perth Amboy

I have always been proud to be an American. My northern granny would continue with the oral tradition of telling each of her grands their family heritage - who was who and etc. We used to think she was nuts when she told us we were related to the Pilgrims and George Washington. Originally at: 99 Broad Street, Perth Amboy, now at: 120 Pleasant Avenue, Edison, NJ 08837-2665. The church was organized on August 20, 1872 (41 people) and on September 15, 1872, the first worship service was conducted in Danish by Pastor Anders Lausen Jensen Søholm. Circa 1875, a church was built on East Avenue. In 1888, a new church was built on the corner of State and Broad Streets. In 1896, a brick church and a frame parsonage were built at 101 Broad Street. In 1939, Crown Prince Frederick and Princess Ingrid of Denmark visited the church. In 1941, dual services in English and Danish were started. In 1949, a Sunday School was built on the corner of First and Pleasant Avenue in Raritan Township (Edison). The Broad Street church was sold in 1957. In 1960, the church was built on Pleasant Avenue in Edison. In 1964, services in Danish were stopped. The records have been copied and we indexed the records. The records are from 1872-1948. - **Forste Dansk Methodist Menighed**

- First Danish Methodist Episcopal Church, Perth Amboy, New Jersey**

The congregation was organized June 1869. The founding members were James Buck, Jacob Thompson, and Nels Hansen. They met in James Buck's home. The church was incorporated October 26, 1874. In 1876, a small frame church was erected at 320 State Street, Perth Amboy, New Jersey. Rev Burriel Smith was church's first pastor. Smith was born in Slesvig, Denmark. The cornerstone for the new church at Madison & Jefferson Street, Perth Amboy was laid on 17 September 1898. The church was dedicated on Sunday 17 December 1899. On Thanksgiving Day 1868 Our Savior's Danish Lutheran Church, Perth Amboy, New Jersey formed a congregation and adopted a constitution. The pastor was Pastor O. Juul. Trustees were Jens Hansen, Hans Jorgensen, and Thomas Thomsen. Treasurer was Hans Jorgensen and Secretary was C.F. Eskesen.

Under the leadership of Pastor V B Skov, a church building was planned in 1889. It was located at State and Market Street. With gifts of labor and materials the church was constructed for six thousand dollars. Dedication was held on Thanksgiving Day 1896. The Danish Home was established in 1914 by the Danish Brotherhood & Sisterhood Lodges of the North East. It was a 72 acre farm located in what was then known as Metuchen, on New Durham Road. The farm was maintained and provided food for the home residents. The old farm house/home burned down in 1952. In 1950 the new Home was dedicated across the road in what is now Edison, at 855 New Durham Road. Much of the property has been sold off with just a few acres remaining. The grounds are now used for picnics and cultural events. Located at the back rear of the property is a Viking style masuoleum/Mindehoyen for interments of Danish Lodge members. The Danish Children's Home was dedicated 7 September 1908 and was located at 56 State Street, Perth Amboy, New Jersey. In 1916 it was moved to 414 Compton Avenue, Perth Amboy. It was in operation until about 1929.

- **Dana Relief Society:** The Dana Relief Society began on September 11, 1884. They met in the home of Jens Andersen at 278 Prospect Street in Perth Amboy. The organization was formed to aid members and their families in times of distress. They set up a fund to pay a fixed sum weekly to a member, who on account of illness, was not able to work. On the death of a member, they paid the widow or other survivors \$200. At the death of his wife, a member was paid \$100. Another fund was set up to assist widows and orphans of members. Meetings were held at Jens Andersen's home until January 1885 and then for 2 years at the home of J.C. Iversen on State Street in Perth Amboy. The upper floor of 107 Smith Street was rented from Therkelsen and Brown until in December 1895, Dana moved to the McCormick building at 90-92 Smith Street. In March 1894, they purchased 2 lots at 224-226 Smith Street almost opposite the Jersey Central Railroad Station. The building was completed about November 1, 1898. ## Dana Relief Here 55 Years

P.A.E.N. 5-5-39  
Danish Society Was Organ-  
ized by Twenty Local  
Residents in 1884

Fifty-five years ago, at the peak of Danish immigration into Perth Amboy, the Danes here had seen how difficult matters became when one of their number was stricken with sickness or death.

In those days, according to Mads H. Madsen, present auditor of the Dana Relief Society, the Danes were a laboring people and as wages were low, they were consequently very poor. Therefore, when sickness or death came these people could barely meet expenses.

It was because of this trying condition, Madsen said, that a group of eighteen men and two youths met together in October, 1884, and formed what is now the Dana Relief Society. One of these men had just returned from a trip to the west, Madsen pointed out, and there had seen the benefits of a similar organization.

When first organized, the society was known as the Sygeforeningen Dana, or "sick society." Its purpose was to accumulate a fund through membership dues, and from this capital, care for the sick or accident-injured members and also help them defray funeral expenses in case of death.

Final organization was effected on Oct. 26, 1884, at a meeting at the home of Jens Andersen, 278 Prospect street with these charter members: Andersen, Christian Hilkjaer, Jens Christian Iversen, Ferdinand Rechnitzer, Rasmus Hansen, F. Hoberg, P. N. Pedersen, Jorgen Andersen, Fred O. Andersen.

S. T. Bollerup, Martin Petersen, P. Andersen, L. C. N. Brogger, Fred L. Brown, Y. P. Therkelsen, Charles Henry, John H. Poulsen, Jorgensen, Carl J. Larsen and Andres Hansen. Of these original members, but two are still alive—the two youths—P. M. Pedersen, now of Kansas City, Kan., and Rasmus Hansen, a former clay miner, who now resides in Bonhamtown.

Meetings were held for the first year at the home of Jens Andersen, and then at the home of Jens Iversen, in State street. Some sessions, Madsen said, were also held at Y. P. Therkelsen's store near the present site of the Raritan Trust Company, in Smith street. Later the meetings took place at the McCormick Building, 90-92 Smith street.

The society progressed rapidly, it was said, many Danes coming to realize the many benefits the organization offered its membership. Therefore, it was not without support that the society erected its first building in Smith street, where the King Arthur store now stands.

This structure, a frame building costing \$1,800, was replaced with a fine brick building on the same site, which was completed in November 1898. This was designed to be a permanent headquarters, but as the society continued to grow the building was sold in 1920.

In the fall and winter of 1922-23 the present Dana Hall was erected in Market street. When completed the Dana Relief society owned the building free and clear and there was no necessity of a mortgage.

The society is believed to be one of the oldest of its kind in America and it certainly is the oldest in this section.

Besides paying members' sick and death benefits, Madsen said, the society provides interesting entertainment for its members. There are regular weekly meetings, and at frequent intervals there are gay social functions. The organization is not interested in politics and is non-sectarian.

The present staff of officers of the Dana Relief Society includes: Herbert Jensen, president; Niels Jensen, vice president; Hans Tonnesen, recording secretary; Sophus Knudsen, financial secretary; Jens M. Olsen, treasurer; Harold Klausen, conductor; Mads H. Madsen and Axel Anderson, auditors; Vincent Knudsen, inner guard; and William Klausen, Oscar Andersen and Peter M. Klausen, trustees.

## 75th Anniversary Planned By Dana Relief Society

Dana Relief Society, char-tered Oct. 16, 1884, will celebrate its 75th anniversary with a dinner-dance tomorrow night at 7 o'clock in Masonic Temple. Cocktails will be served at 6:30 p.m. and dinner at 7 o'clock.

Fred Jorgensen is general chairman of dance arrangements with Hans Tonnesen chairman of the ticket committee and Arnie Kjems of refreshments. Harold Johnson is handling publicity and compiling a history of Dana Relief Society in connection with the anniversary.

Honored during tomorrow night's proceedings will be 27 who have been members of Dana Relief Society for 50 years or more; three of these for 68 years: Eskil Tjornelund of Perth Amboy, B. K. Eskesen of Keyport and Carl Hansen of Staten Island. Prominent citizens who are members include City Commissioner Donald Olsen and former Governor Morgan F. Larson.

### How It Began

Dana Relief Society began with a meeting of men of Danish birth Sept. 11, 1884, in the home of the late Jens Andersen, 278 Prospect St., to discuss forming an organization to aid members and their families in times of distress. On Oct. 12 the group formed "Sygeforenningen Dana." (Sick Benefit Society Dana.) This was later changed to the present name.

Charter members were Andersen, Christian Hilkjaer, Jens C. Iversen, Ferdinand Rechnitzer, Rasmus Hansen, F. Hoeberg, P. N. Pedersen, Jorgen Andersen, Fred C. Andersen, S. T. Bollerup, Martin Petersen, P. Andersen, L. C. Brogger, Fred L. Brown, Y. P. Therkelsen, Charles Henry, John H. Poulsen, Jorgen Jorgensen, Carl J. Larsen and Anders Hansen.

The first officers were Brog-

ger, president; Andersen, treasurer, and Rechnitzer, secretary.

The stated purpose was to set up a fund to pay a fixed sum week to a member, who on account of illness, was unable to work, and on death of a member pay to the widow or other survivors \$200. At the death of his wife, a member was paid \$100. Another fund was set up to assist widows and orphans of members.

Meetings were held at Andersen's home until January 1885, and for two years after at the home of J. C. Iversen on State St. The upper floor of 107 Smith St. was rented from Therkelsen and Brown until in December, 1895, Dana moved to the McCormick building, 90-92 Smith St.

In March, 1894, it was decided to purchase two lots at 224-226 Smith St., almost opposite the Jersey Central Railroad Station. The price was paid in full by April, 1897, and a building committee planned the erection of a hall. A contract for construction of a brick building was awarded to Carl M. Christensen with J. K. Jensen as architect.

Ground was broken June 4 and the building completed about Nov. 1, 1898. This was Dana's home for many years. The society's only mortgage was burned early in 1910. This property was sold Aug. 1, 1920, to Emil Koyen, since Dana outgrew the Smith St. building and needed a place for recreational and social purposes, besides a meeting room.

The present Dana Hall on Market St. was built on plans of Architect Graysen.

A history of Dana points out that Dana has paid out through the years many thousands of dollars to members and their survivors and invested considerable sums in Liberty and Victory Bonds. Many members distinguished themselves in

service for their country in the wars and some never came back.

In addition to its philanthropic work, Dana has contributed to the social life of the city with its basketball games and dances, and other social events.

## Danish 100 Men's Society Is Active

The Danish 100 Men's Society, organized in October, 1901, is still an active organization.

McKinley Hall, Elm street, where the saloon of Ove Poulsen was located, was its first meeting place. By-laws of a similar organization in Denmark, to which Fred Christensen belonged, were obtained by him and used as a guide for the local group, organized as a sick benefit organization.

Some of the old members who were active in its early days were: Fred Christensen, the only living charter member; Hans Petersen, Hemming Larsen and Christ Miller. Among those resting in Alpine cemetery are: John H. Poulsen, Policeman Hansen, Hilmar Christensen, Pete Madsen and Mathias Christensen.

By 1910, the 100 Men and its affiliated group, the Danish 100 Ladies, had become firmly established financially and met frequently for dances, picnics and other social occasions. Among those active today are: Victor Jacobsen, Pete Børner, Christ Madsen, Rasmus Johnsen, Pete Jensen, John Petersen, Christ Andersen, Pete Lehman and Marius Jensen, the latter president during the depression years.

After the World War there was always a waiting list for membership and it was finally decided to increase the membership to 150. However, at the end of the depression this had decreased to 73 despite the fact that \$200 was taken out of the treasury to pay dues of old members who were unable to do so themselves. Twenty-year membership was the qualification for this.

Semi-annual meetings are made a festive occasion in the form of a stag party with approximately 75 members present at the last affair.

Officers serving this year are: President, Anton Nissen; Vice president, M. Madsen; financial secretary, John Petersen; recording secretary, Christ Andersen; treasurer, Peter Lehman.

Athletics fostered twenty-five years ago and in later years under the direction of the Danish Sociable Athletic club was the subject of a conversation by Math Hansen, former overseer of the poor, and Clarkson Dunham, a former police sergeant, a few days ago. Hansen and Dunham were two of the most enthusiastic followers of the Danish club's undertakings in the good old days.

It was a cold winter night in 1902 when Peter Hansen, Chris Hansen, deceased; Jens Frills, Gus Madsen and Martinus Lauritzen organized what later proved to be one of the strongest organizations of its kind in this city, the Danish Sociable Athletic club. The first meeting was held in a shed in the rear of what is now Melbourne & Ritter's Accessory store at the corner of Park Avenue and New Brunswick Avenue.

#### Building Erected

With the membership steadily increasing it was necessary some time later for J. S. Hansen to erect a two-story frame building on New street, this center later being considered one of the foremost athletic and gymnastic clubs in the state.

A feature of the club's early activities was the gymnastic team operating under the direction of Instructor Nels Fonskov, deceased, who looked after the Danish gym stars, Marinus Hansen, Walter Mathiasen, Henry Axen, Hans Svarre, Chris Hansen, deceased; Peter M. Hansen, Peter Hansen, Martinus Lauritzen and Hans Stockel.

The Danish gymnastic team met and defeated some of the best outfits in the eastern section of the country, including the Norwegian Turn club, of Brooklyn. The Norwegians were considered in a class by themselves until they were

#### H. P. Hansen

Wrestling now enters the conversation between the poor master and former police sergeant, and the first name to come to their minds is none other than H. P. Hansen, middleweight professional champion who aided in a big way to make local athletic history. Hansen carried the colors of the D. S. A. C. and his contests in Muscle hall on High street, Wilder hall on Smith street and other local centers, are well remembered by a great many local residents of today.

Some of Hansen's biggest battles were with Charley Leonhart, of Newark; Professor Dwyer and other lesser lights of the middleweight division. In order to get opposition, Hansen engaged many heavyweights mostly in handicap matches. Jack Munroe weighed 220 pounds for a bout with Hansen, Tom Sharkey tipped the scales at 190, Led Pardello at 225; Tom Jenkins, a world's champion, at 210, and Dan McLeod, at 200. Hansen, at the time, weighed in the vicinity of 170 pounds and stood five feet, nine inches in height. Considering handicaps and the opposition encountered, it can be readily seen that the middleweight mat star was worthy of comparison with the best of today.

Among the other star wrestlers in the early days of the Danish club were John Larson, a police sergeant in the local department at present; Jorgen Hansen, Peter Jensen, the latter of Keyport; Hans Stockel, Hans Svarre and Chris Miller, all heavyweights, and Marinus Hansen, Peter Hansen, Walter Mathiasen, Henry Axen, Charles Howe, Chris Larsen, Johnny Janderup, Jimmie Christensen and numerous other classy boys whose names are not available at this time, the latter group being lightweights.

#### Basketball Action

Growing steadily the Danish Sociable Athletic club never missed an opportunity to assist in sport promotion and when a city basketball league was formed at the New Brunswick avenue auditorium by Joe Billot, the Danes were in line with the Puritans, Marions, Owls, Y. M. H. A., Lyceums and Dexters, Danes in Baseball

In 1910, Messrs. Hansen and Dunham make known, the Danish Sociable Athletic club added baseball to its program by buying the interests and property of the Emerald A. C., a noted amateur outfit. From that time on the Danes ball team gained recognition as one of the leading strictly amateur ball clubs in the state. Numbered among their victims were the Richard K. Fox nine of Fairhaven, N. J., the team which possessed the South Amboy ex-leaguer, the late Sport Kelly, sensational first sacker. The Fox nine was one of the leading semi-pro clubs in South Jersey. Morris was the leading hurler on the Fairhaven roster.

Lakewood, Point Pleasant, Fort Hancock, Clinton Avenue A. C., of Plainfield, and other leading nines were met and defeated by the locals. Playing

Every victory was appreciated by the D. S. A. C. ball squad, but the biggest celebration followed the recording of a 9 to 2 win at the expense of the Kingwoods, of Woodbridge. Billy Ryan, present mayor of Woodbridge, pitched for the Kingwoods that day and if the entire team had performed as did the pitcher the opposition would have encountered a stiffer battle. Many of the hits collected by the Danes that day should have been easy outs. On the receiving end for the Kingwoods was Bill Clooney, police clerk of the local

department. Clooney as a catcher and batter rated with the best.

Eight strike-outs were registered against the Danes in that particular encounter through the excellent maneuvering of Ryan and Clooney. Yet Ryan elected to quit the diamond and is now prominent in politics and Clooney passed up a chance to get into the majors and is now directing the protection of local residents. The former backstop, originally with the Emeralds, is prominent in state police circles today, being secretary of the Jersey P. B. A.

Johnny Jorgenson, ex-Emerald pitcher, managed the Danes in those days and he was later succeeded by Police Sergeant John Larson, who remained at the helm until the outfit disbanded in 1913. A few years ago Ed Koehler and his "old roundhouse," Ed Poulsen, Pete Peterson and Stevie Christiansen were induced to return to the diamond to beat the cream of that season, the St. Anthonys, in three consecutive games.

Clarkie Dunham is smoking away on the old corncob and Math Hansen is rubbing his whiskers for further news regarding the good "old D. S. A. C." as this conversation nears its end. The former police sergeant can't forget to give credit to Paul Martin, deceased; Math Hansen and other Danish residents who rallied to the aid of the organization to make the various undertakings possible. The name made by the D. S. A. C. in the sporting world will live forever.

# Frem Singing Society Active

## Danish Organization Will Observe 30th Anniversary in November

The Singing Society Frem, which boasts of some of Perth Amboy's best vocal talent, has as singing director, Rolf Gunst, of Metuchen.

Founded Nov. 7, 1909, the society met for singing exercises in Dana hall, at that time located on Smith street. Charter members were: Albert Larsen, president and leader; Ove A. Thomsen, secretary; Wilhelm Zangenberg, treasurer. In October, 1911 Frem purchased a lot on the corner of Lehigh avenue and Prospect street and the following year constructed its own building. The ground cost \$1,365. Material for the building was mostly donated and all work was done voluntarily. Since then it has been enlarged and added to three times.

At its second anniversary, celebrated in Kroeger's auditorium, Market Street Frem had the Danish opera singer, Hans Petersen, and M. Enna, editor of "Nordlyset" as guests. Members of the Singing Society of Denmark, of Lansingburg, were special guests over Labor Day weekend, 1913, and were later initiated into Frem's Brammer club. The following year saw the organization of Vaaren, a Danish singing society in Newark with which Frem associated as long as it existed. A new and stronger society, "Danmark," took its place and under the leadership of Rolf Gunst is now firmly established.

One of Frem's customs is to serenade Danish-American residents who have reached a creditable age on their birthdays or other anniversaries. Each year, early in May, Frem is invited by the Knights of Columbus glee club to sing at its annual concert and dance in the K. of C. auditorium, High street. In turn they cooperate with Frem and participate at its fall concert. Last year at the K. of C. invitation, Frem Singing Society, the Ladies' Singing Society Frem and the Danmark Singing Society, participated with Rolf Gunst, director of them all, wielding the baton at the K. of C. glee club concert and dance.

Another annual event eagerly looked forward to throughout the community is Frem's excursion, up the Hudson, to Bear Mountain or some other popular place. Two members honored with testimonial dinners by Frem are Victor Jacobson and Hans P. Rosenvinge.

Both Frem and Danmark expect to sing at the Danish Day observance at the New York World's Fair, June 5, that date being to Danish people what Independence Day is to Americans.

Present officers are: Fred Hansen, president; Niels Kaer, secretary; Albert Larsen, treasurer; Victor Jacobson, financial secretary.

## Ladies' Frem

The Ladies' Singing Society Frem was organized four years ago in April, 1935, by its president, Mrs. Elna Borgstrom, She, with other ladies whose husbands were members of Frem Singing Society, got together at a meeting at the Borgstrom home, Amboy avenue, and decided to form their own unit.

This was done and the group met weekly for rehearsals or some form of social activity with Albert Larson as singing director. Permission was granted to use Frem hall as a meeting place. Since then the organization has expanded until its present membership numbers seventy-five.

Five years ago it was decided to renovate the building both on the in and outside, from top to bottom, a work that was completed by many Danish artisans, specialists in carpentry, masonry, painting, wiring and associated crafts."

From the first seventeen members, has sprung up a society now totalling more than 300 members, all engaged in the task of aiding one another socially and in times of need.

### Home for the Aged

The Home for the Aged at Matuchen is a project which was completed under the joint sponsorship of the Danish Brotherhood and Sisterhood.

Well known for its attractive grounds, which comprise more than 100 acres of land, the home is a beautiful colonial mansion offering a handsome home for the aged of the two societies. The place has annually attracted thousands of visitors, and countless picnics have been held at "Tivoli" the grove on the grounds.
