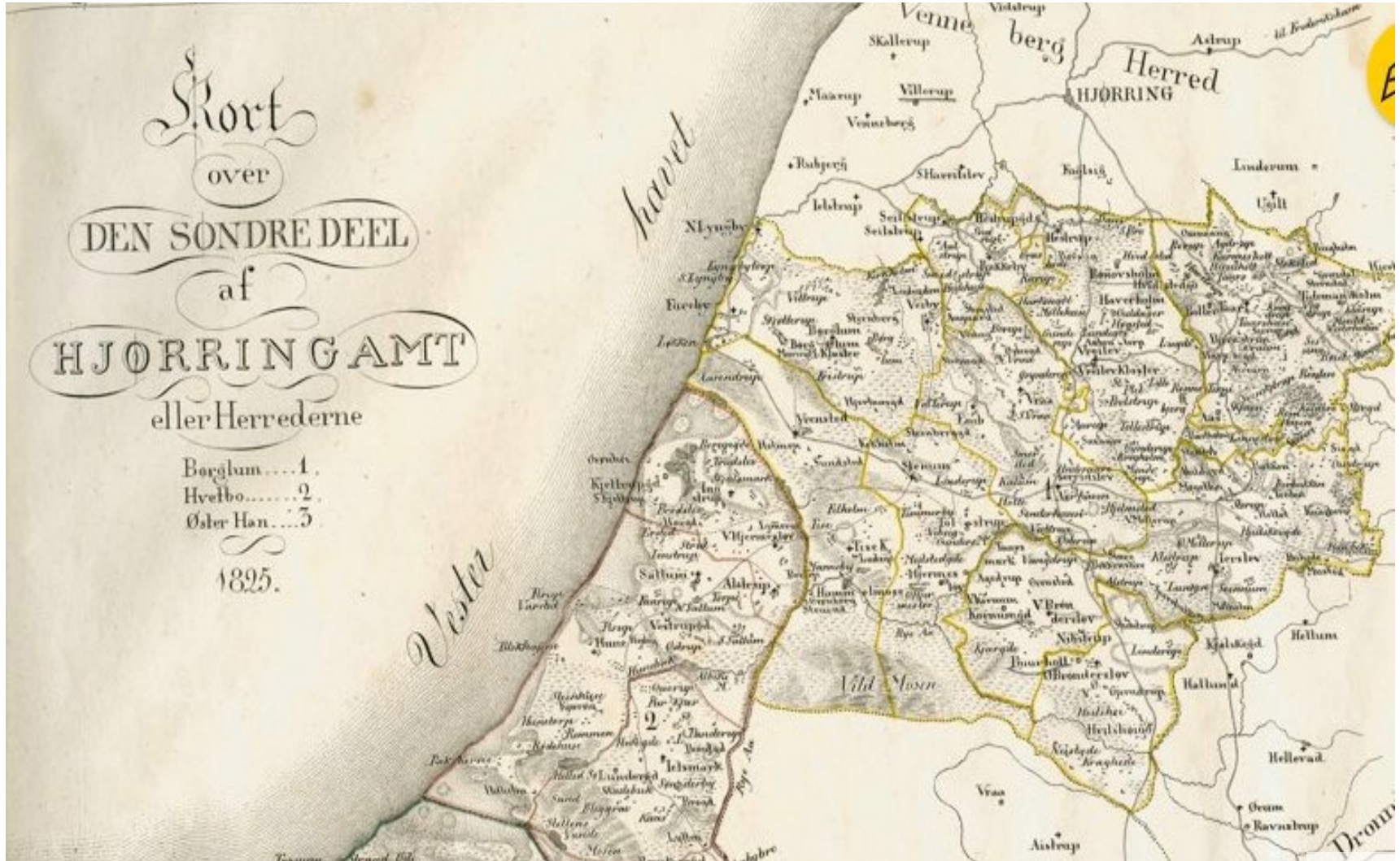

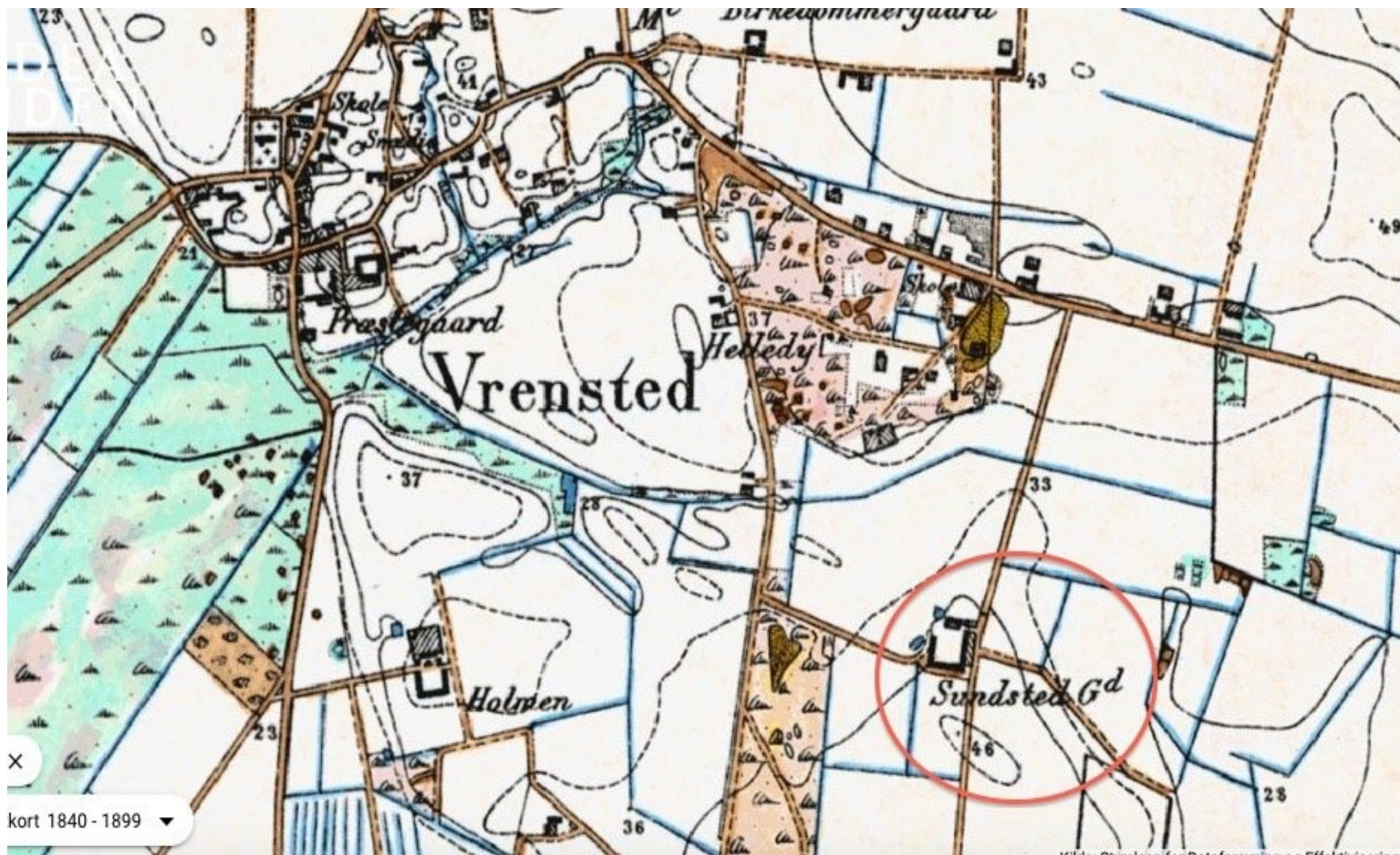
**1825 Map of western VENDSYSSEL - HJØRRING AMT -  
the town of VRENSTED**





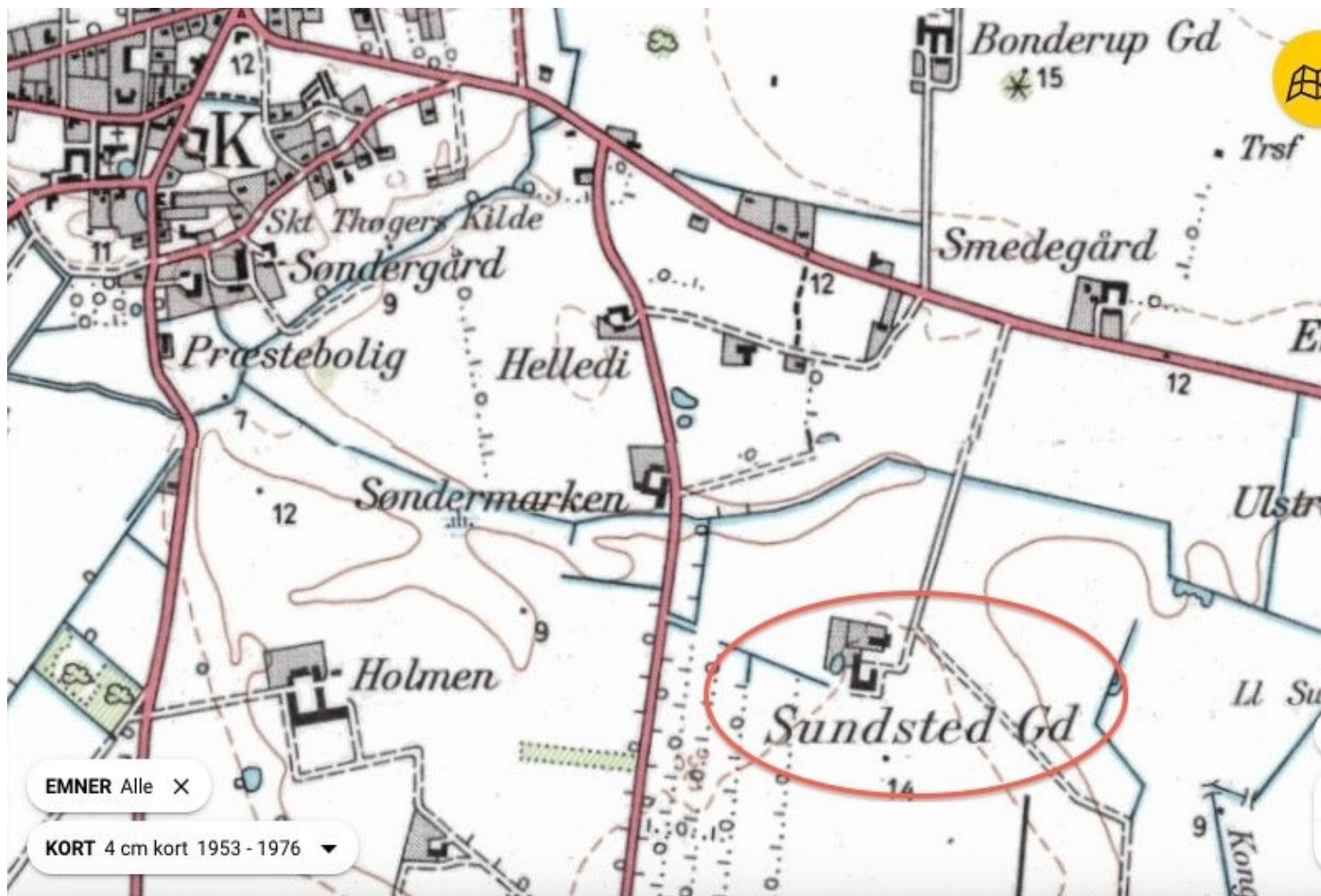

## **CHRISTEN (Chresten) KNUDSEN SUNDSTED (1793-1876)**

*(Born 15 Sept. 1793, Thise – died 6  
July 1866, Vrensted).*

## **ANE MARIE (Chrestensdatter) KNUDSEN SUNDSTED (1810-1856)**

*(Born 4 June 1810 on Vestergaard in  
Faarup – died 28 August 1856 in  
Vrensted.)*

They married in Saltum, 19 Oct. 1838.  
(He was 45, she was 28 years old.)  
No photographs exist.

## VRENSTED CHURCH - BAPTISMAL FONT



Christen and his wife, Anne Marie lived on the farm, **Sundstedgaard** from 1839.

Their five children: **A-1. Ane Kathrine, B-2. Knud, C-3. Christiane, D-4. Mette Kirstine and E-5. Chresten**, were baptised in Vrensted Church.

The mother Ane Marie, died in 1856, 46 years old, after 18 years of marriage. The father, Christen Knudsen Sundsted was 61 years old.

The family's oldest child, the daughter Ane Kathrine was 17 years old. The oldest son, Knud was 16. The youngest child, Chresten, was only 2 years old.

Christen Knudsen Sundsted did not remarry, but lived on the farm with his children. He died, 72 years old, in 1866.

*(b.1812 in Vrensted - d.1886, in Vrensted)*

Ane Kathrine Christensdatter and Thomas Sørensen married in Vrensted, 26 March 1867. They lived in the town of Nr. Sundby where they owned a clothing store.

They had 4 children:

**Christen Severin, Søren Theodor, Anne Marie,** and **Antine**, (who died 6 years old).

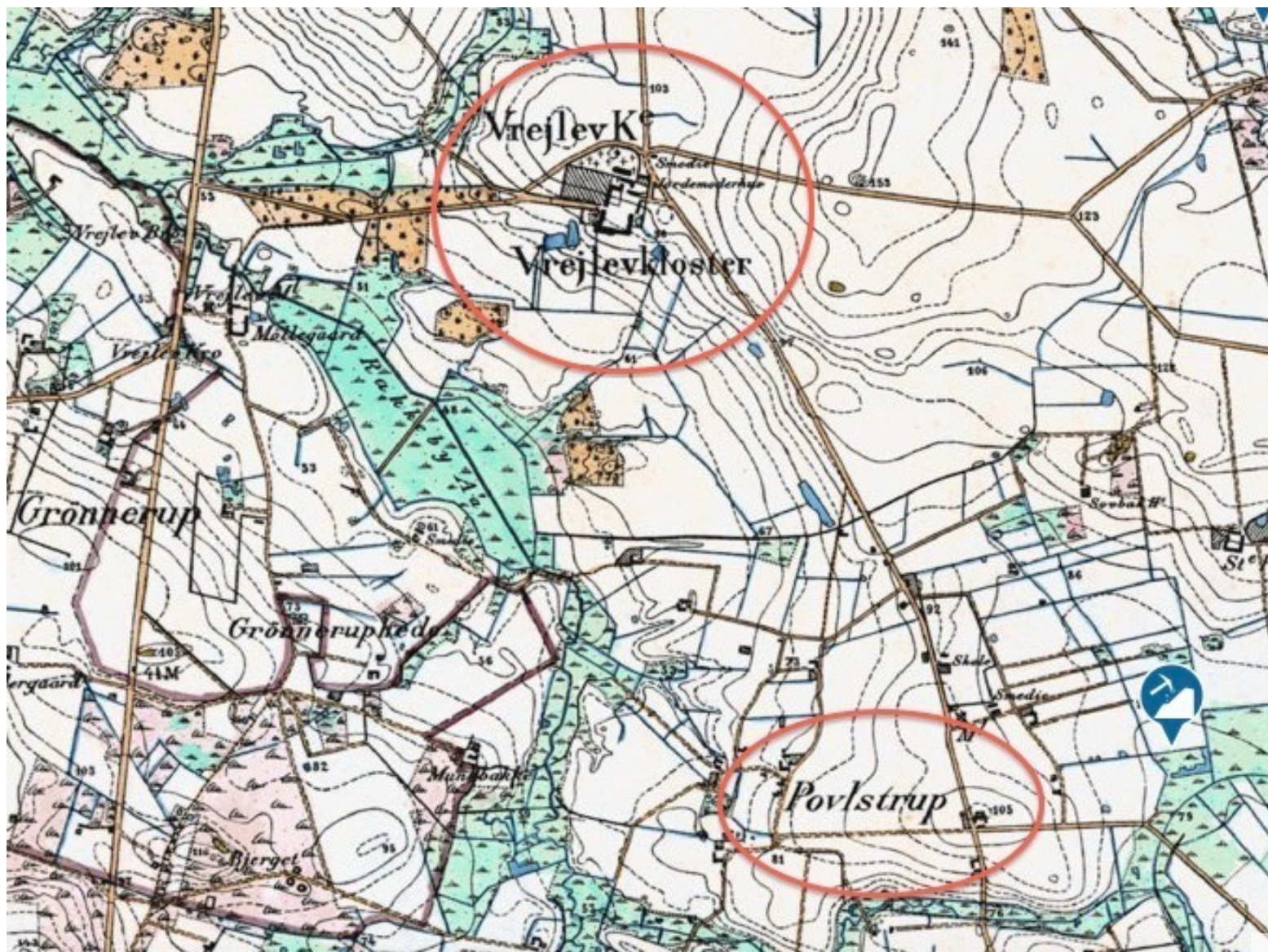

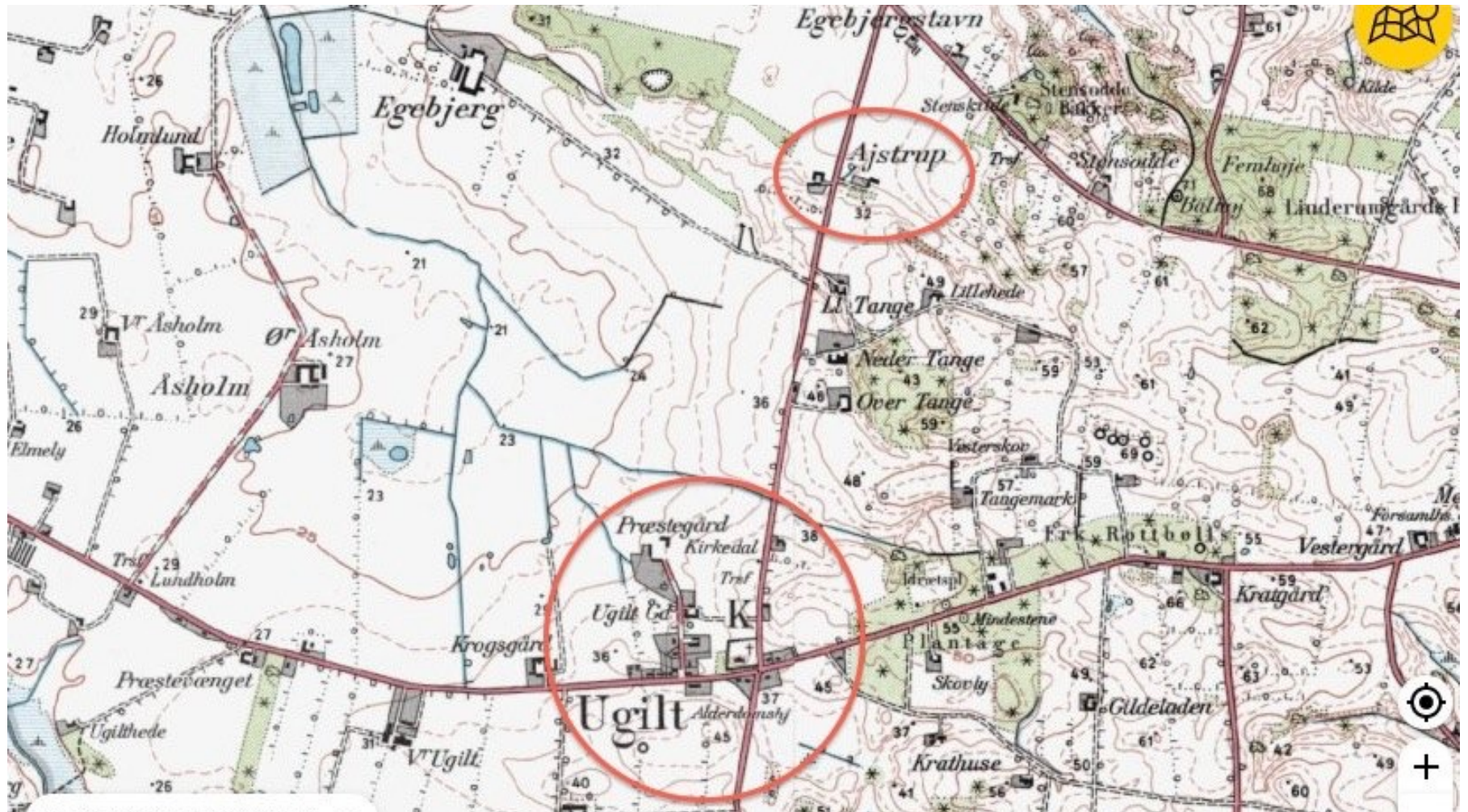

Born 10 Sept. 1875, Poulstrup, Vrejlev parish. Baptised, 9 January 1876. Died, 5 Sept. 1951, Racine, WI

## **E-5. CHRISTEN “Chris” C.C. CHRISTENSEN SUNDSTED** **(1854-1921)**



### **E-5. Christen, “Chris” Sundsted**

The youngest of the five children, born on the family farm in Vrensted in 1854. In 1866, their father died and “Sundstedgaard” was sold.

In 1878 Chris married **Edel Elsine Eriksen** (1851-1880), a sister of his brother Knud’s wife). Chris’ military service must have taken place before he married (some time between 1872 - 74).

Chris and Edel lived in the small town of Vrensted, just like his older sister, **C-3. Christiane**, who was married and lived on a farm near by.

After his wife Edel died, their two-year-old daughter, **Magdalene**, (1879 -1949) also called **“Maggie”** came to live with “Aunt Kristiana” on her farm.

Her father remarried, and “Maggie” had close contact with her father and his new family, until they emigrated in 1890, taking her with them to America.

**Marie Magdalene "Aunt Marie"

*Born 2 April 1886, Poulstrup, Vrejlev parish. Baptised ,11 May 1886). Died 1 February 1971 Sheridan, Montana.*

**Emigrated to USA 1906, 20 years old**

After her mother, Karen died in 1898, Marie (by then 12 years old) was taken in by her fathers younger sister, C-3. Christiane Jensen, "Aunt Christiana" (Tante Jane") (1843-1921). Christiana was 55 years old and lived with her husband on their farm in Vrensted.

taken in by her father, Knud Sundsted's  
older sister **A-1. Ane Kathrine  
Sørensen** (1839-1914). Ane was 59  
years old and lived in Nr. Sundby.

### **CHRISTIANE JENSEN “Aunt Christiana” (“Tante Jane”)**

*Born 20 April 1843, in Vrensted. Died  
18 May 1921, in Nr. Sundby,  
Denmark.*

*First marriage: Peder Christensen,  
breadcart driver in Nørre Sundby. Second  
marriage: Thomas Poulsen, farmer in  
Vrensted. Third marriage: Jens Jensen,  
farmer in Vrensted.*

Christiane had no children of her own, but she took care of the 3 young children left in her care by her brother Knud Sundsted, B-2. and her sister Mette Kirstine Sundsted (Pedersen), D-4.

*Born 22 January 1848, Vrensted.  
Died 7 July 1919 in Harlan, Iowa.*

**Emigrated to USA 1880, 32 years old.**

Her husband:

### **Peder Christian Pedersen,**

*Born 14 February 1855 Jetsmark,  
Denmark. Died 26 March 1923, in  
Harlan, Iowa.*

Peder Christian Pedersen emigrated a year before his wife Mette arrived in 1880.

They had 3 children: two born in Denmark, one child born in USA.

## **D-4. Mette “Stinne” Kirstine Christensdatter (1848-1919)**

**CHILDREN: Chris, born 1878 & Thomas, born 1880**

### **D-4. METTE “Stinne” KIRSTINE PEDERSEN (Peterson) 1848-1919**

Her first son, **Christian “Little Chris” Pedersen** was born 24 January 1878 in Nr. Sundby. Denmark.

Christian was two years in 1880, when his mother, Mette Kristine Pedersen, emigrated from Hamburg to America with his baby brother, **Thomas Peterson**. (born 1879)

“Little Chris” was left in the care of his mother’s older sister, **C-3. Kristiane Christensdatter Jensen**, “Aunt Kristiana” (“Tante Jane”) on her farm in Vrensted. She was then 37 years old.

Ten years later, in 1890 when he was about 12 years old, “Little Chris” emigrated to America with “Maggie’s” father, his second wife, Ane Marie and their children, Anna Marie (1885) and Thomas (1890)





## **MAGDALENE "Maggie" & COUSIN "LITTLE CHRIS"**

### **MAGDALENE, "Maggie" SUNDSTED**

Daughter of E-5. Chris,"C.C. Sundsted" and his first wife, Edel Elsin Eriksen.

Born 28 October 1879, in Vrensted. Died 27 June 1949, Plentywood Montana. Since her mother's death in 1880, "Maggie" had been living with her father's sister, C-3. "Aunt Christiane", on her farm in Vrensted.

Her cousin, Christian, "Little Chris" Pedersen, (born January 24, 1878), son of her father's sister, D-4. Mette, "Stinne", also lived on Aunt Christiane's farm in Vrensted. The two young cousins were brought up as brother and sister.

### **EMIGRATED TO USA, 1890**

Both children emigrated in 1890 to America with "Maggie's" father, C.C. Sundsted, his second wife, Ane Marie and their children, Anna Marie (1885) and Thomas (1890)



## CHRISTIAN "LITTLE CHRIS" and his cousin THEODOR

**Christian "Little Chris" Pedersen**,  
(born in Nr. Sundby January 24, 1878).  
Son of Metta "Stinne" and Peder  
Christian Pedersen.

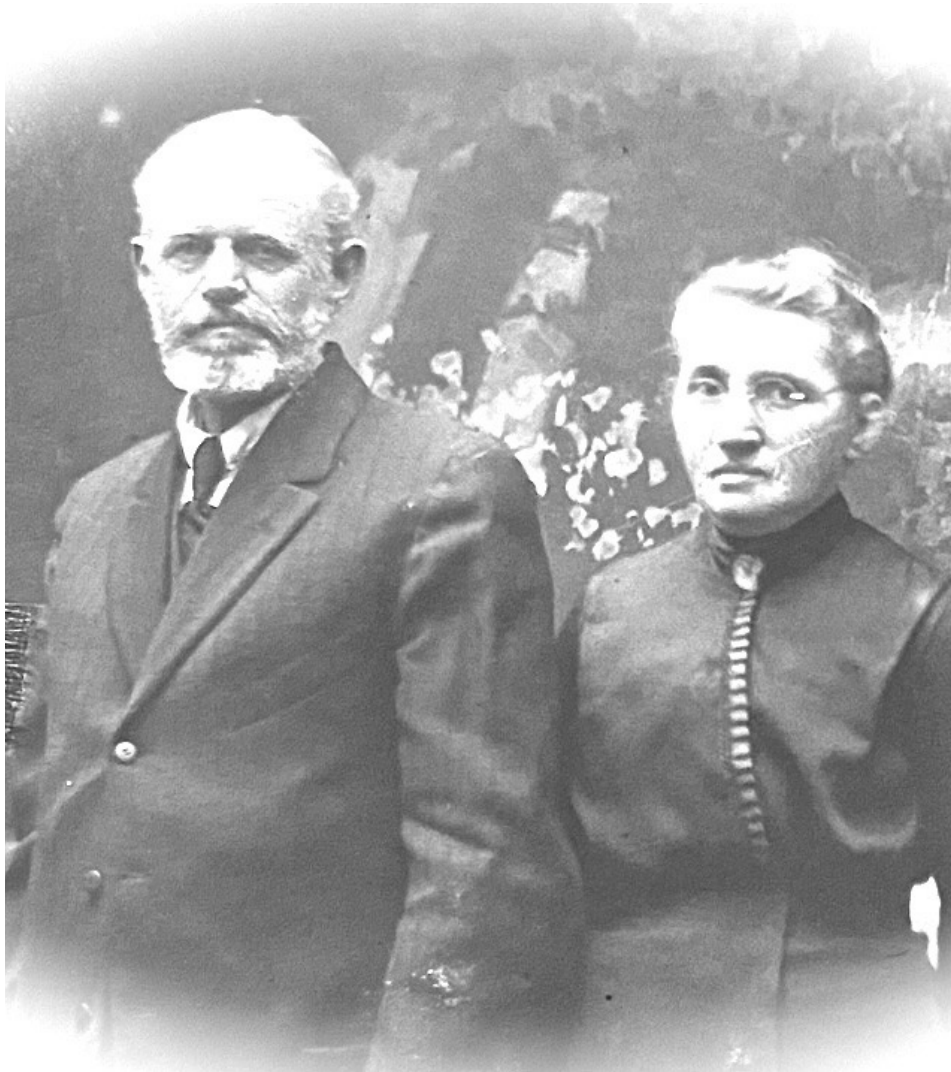
In 1880, two years old, he came to live  
with his mother's older sister, "Aunt  
Kristiana", **C-3. Christiane Jensen**, on  
her farm in Vrensted.

Earlier that same year, the boys one-  
year younger cousin, "**Maggie**", (born  
Oct. 28, 1879), daughter of his mother's  
widowed brother, E-5. Christen "Chris"  
(C.C.) Sundsted, had also come to live  
with her father's older sister, **C-3.**  
**"Aunt Christiana"**.

The boy standing next to "Little Chris",  
could be his cousin, the 7 year older,  
**Søren Theodor Sørensen** (born 19 April  
1870), son of Mette's older sister in Nr.

## **THOMAS CHRISTENSEN SUNDSTED (1890-1958) & his cousin “Chris” Knudsen Sundsted, (1875 -1951)**

### **Thomas C. Sundsted.**

(Son of E-5. **Christen, “C.C. Sundsted”**). Born in Vrensted, May 12, 1890 – died Dec. 30, 1958, Racine Wisconsin.

Thomas was one year old when he arrived in USA with his family in 1890.

Sitting:

Thomas' cousin, **“Chris” Knudsen Sundsted**, son of Thomas' father's older brother, B-2. **Knud Sundsted.**

“Chris” was born in Poulstrup in 1875. He Emigrated to USA in 1901. 26 years old.
